PROCESS STAGE	POTENTIAL RISK	CONTROL MEASURES	ACTION REQUIRED
DELIVERY			
Packaged ready to use in 240gm plastic shaker pots. Re-sealable top.	Risk of spillage if the container is dropped.	Take care not to drop shaker pots. Ensure that the top is secured at all times.	Transfer container to store immediately following delivery. Do not leave containers in areas where users of the building will come into contact with them.
STORAGE			
Containers must be stored upright in a cool, dry storage area. Product must be kept stored in its original container. Keep pots tightly closed when not in use.	Minimal risk of spillage if pots are firmly sealed. Tops are not child proof.	Keep pots in secure storage areas. Store all pots below chest height to minimise risk of dropping. Restrict access to storage areas to authorised personnel. Never use near foodstuffs	Use oldest stock first. Make regular checks to ensure that storage area is clean and tidy. Make regular checks to ensure pots are not split or blown.
USAGE			
Product can be sprinkled from the shaker pot liberally over the spillage and contaminated area and left for about 90 seconds.	Risk of severe skin and eye contact and damage. Risk of ingestion. Risk of inhalation. Risk of spillage onto floor and into drainage system. Take care when opening tubs and open away from the body and face.	Handle the pots with care. Wear Personal Protective Equipment. Use with ventilation. Avoid creating dust which can be inhaled or cause flammable dust clouds. Ensure that the pot is returned to the store when not in use. Never dispense near foodstuffs.	Provide employees with PPE as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Protective gloves • Safety Goggles • Protective clothing In case of insufficient ventilation, wear suitable respiratory equipment Ensure that operatives are aware of location of First Aid facilities
DISPOSAL			
Residual stocks/exhausted product must be disposed of in line with Local Authority Guidelines	Small risk of skin or eye contact. Small risk of inhalation and ingestion. Risk of contamination with other substances.	Do not store any other material in the empty container. Ensure that the product is exhausted before disposal. Ensure that the product is not disposed of via a rainwater sewer (ie drain outside the building).	Ensure that all operatives wear Personal Protective Equipment at all times during disposal. Ensure that all operatives are aware of the First Aid equipment.
